More than 60 businesses, trade associations, non-profits, and research institutions form NASEO's Affiliates network. Through this program, NASEO helps companies understand the unique priorities and perspectives of state energy policy makers and shares private sector expertise to help State Energy Offices understand the critical need for public-private partnerships to address challenges in the sector.

### WHY JOIN?

#### VOICE YOUR PERSPECTIVES AND SHARE EXPERTISE

Affiliates help State Energy Offices align their policy and program efforts with private sector innovations, knowledge, and investments. Opportunities to share your unique insights and important energy expertise, and increase visibility for your organization, include:

- ❖ Conferences and Meetings: Affiliates receive one complimentary pass to either of NASEO's two major annual conferences, the Energy Policy Outlook Conference (held every February in Washington, D.C.) or the NASEO Annual Meeting (held every September in varying locations). As a member your company also has early opportunities to submit input and ideas for NASEO conference sessions and discuss potential speaking opportunities with NASEO staff.
- ❖ Topical Committees: NASEO engages state energy directors and their staff on a wide variety of issues, including energy security, grid modernization, energy-efficient buildings, transportation, and financing. Affiliates with expertise on these issues are often featured in committee discussions.
- ❖ NASEO Projects and Publications: NASEO frequently partners with Affiliates on special projects, joint publications, and informational campaigns. This allows NASEO staff to tap into Affiliates' knowledge of private sector projects and successes to make the information we share with State Energy Offices robust and compelling.

- ❖ Special invitations to participate in NASEO Board and committee meetings, webinars, project update calls, and other special initiatives;
- ❖ Exclusive opportunities to attend NASEO's regional meeting series (held every spring), to learn about priorities and opportunities for collaboration among State Energy Offices at the regional level;
- ❖ In-person and phone briefings with NASEO's expert staff to learn more about the State Energy Offices and their activities.
