

+ Benefits of a State Energy Plan

- Elevate state energy office role
- Define a strategy
- Establish stakeholder consensus
- Encourage cost savings in the public and private sectors
- Achieve competitive economic advantage and growth, jobs
- Address sustainability, security, reliability, resiliency
- Promote resource diversity

THEMES

Pre-2010:

- Reduce dependence on fossil fuels and foreign oil
- Enhance energy reliability through grid improvements and ensuring adequate supply
- Reduce GHG emissions

Post-2010:

- Enhance economic development
 - Create jobs
 - Improve workforce development
 - Spur innovation and technology
- Reduce energy use
- Enhance energy affordability

Update on NASEO Planning Activities

Over the next six months NASEO will update the State Planning Guidance.

Adding new data and tools, and example state approaches and documents for adaptation and use.

Seeking SEO input on planning-related information in the following areas:

- Grid modernization (smart grid, renewable energy and energy efficiency integration, storage).
- Energy and air program integration (e.g., identifying methods of capturing the multi-pollutant benefits of energy efficiency).
- Integration of transportation efficiency, alternative fuels, and land use planning.
